Accommodation is reserved and paid to the hotel "Kolovare" until May 13, 2023. After this date, reservations will be confirmed according to availability.

If you want to book only half board or bed and breakfast, the deductions are as follows:

- for half board: 4 € per person per day

Drinks are not included in the price and all guests pay for it on the spot. Check-in at the hotel: after 14.00

Method of booking and payment

Participants book and pay for their accommodation for themselves (on the spot or in advance according to the proforma invoice).

Cancellation conditions

In case of cancellation Hotels Zadar d.d. will charge the guest a cancellation fee according to the following conditions:

45 days before arrival Hotels Zadar d.d. will not charge the guest for cancelling the reservation.

How to get to Zadar

By car:

Getting to Zadar from via Slovenia: Zadar is situated about 260-270 km from the closest border crossings to Slovenia. If you are coming from direction Italy – Slovenia, the most obvious border crossing is Jelšane/ (Rupa), if you enter from direction Ljubljana, the border crossing would be Petrina / Brod na Kupi or Obrežje / Bregana. If you are entering from direction Graz / Maribor the obvious border crossing would be Gruškovje / (Macelj).

The fastest road from the Slovenian border, is in all cases the Croatian highway, (tool fees apply). When you approached Zadar on the highway you should take exit Zadar II.

By Plane:

Zadar airport is well connected to other major Croatian and European cities. Flying to Zadar can be quite budget friendly as well, considering the fact that you can choose to travel with a low cost company such as Ryanair, which offers many flights to Zadar, especially during the summer months.

If you are arriving to Zadar by plane, it is useful to know that there are airport buses approximately every 30 minutes after the arrival of a scheduled flight. The first station of the airport bus is the bus terminal in Zadar, and afterwards the bus continues to the city center. By Train:

As trains in this part of Croatia move very slow, getting to Zadar by train is only an option if you insist on travelling by train. If you do so you will arrive at the railway station which is next to the main bus station.

By Bus:

You can easily reach Zadar by bus from other European cities because it is very well connected. There are direct bus lines from Vienna and Munich to Zadar, to mention but a few, and if you are departing from some other European city that does not have a direct bus line to Zadar, you can first travel to Zagreb or Split and then change the bus there.

The main bus station in Zadar is located at 1 Ante Starcevica and 100m from the hotel "ZaDar". the exact location on the map can be found here. To get to the city center from the main bus station, you can use the bus lines nr. 2 and 4.

By Ferry:

For those who prefer to travel by ferry, the only way to reach Zadar by ferry is from Ancona. The ferry port in Zadar is about 3.5 km away from the city center. You can reach the old town from Gazenica ferry port by bus line nr. 9.
